

# Psychic sees a positive future for Tahoe

Dayle Schear is a psychic who splits her time between Tahoe and Hawaii. She has hosted radio shows for 25 years and performed at several casinos. Schear has written five books. She spoke to us about her first novel, "Angel Over the Airways," which will be published in March. And she provides some hints on Tahoe's future.

**When did you start to feel you were psychic?** Some people are born with it, and that means it's just there.

I inherited it genetically. My mother, father and grandmother were psychic, so it was just very natural to be this way. And my mother encouraged it. She would teach me that it was OK to say these things that I would feel or dream about.

**What are the types of psychics?** When you are going to a psychic, you should pick the one that matches you. I specialize in the future. I also deal with the present. I also specialize in crossing over to the other side. That's the heaven; that's where the souls reside.

**What do you say to people who doubt?** I truly believe that everyone is entitled to their beliefs. I don't shove it down anybody's throat. I've turned many skeptics into believers.

**What's your reward?** I look at it this way: Through my gift, I'm able to help people. If I can help just one person in mankind, then I've helped a world full of souls.

I help put people on the right path when they are lost in love or life, when they are not sure what to do. When they don't know the proper road, I guide them to the right path.

questions: when we die, is there more? I have validated proof from the other side that there is more.

**There are some people who think psychics are against their religion.** ESP, extra sensory perception, has nothing to do with religion. It's a portion of the brain that is not being utilized. We all as psychics believe in God, all the ones I know of. We are not prophets. I've had priests and rabbis come to me.

The people that won't come to me are the people who will have an early death. They are scared to come near me. And criminals won't come near me.

**You are an author?** "Angel Over the Airways" will be my fifth book and my first novel. A lot of it is about me; I was on the radio for 25 years.

**What's your message in this book?** There's a lot of spiritual teachings in the book. Before I started, I was on the fence about past lives. But as I wrote about Amy, the angel, I got a lot of channeled information from the other side.

It taught me, as I was writing, about past lives. And lifetime after lifetime how we are meant to be and find our twin soul. There's only one twin soul, and that's the other part of us that we are missing.

It came down to these little questions:

Is it possible to find the love of

our life in this lifetime? Or do we search endlessly until we finally get it right? Or do we have to wait until we reach Heaven's gate?

Or is our love for someone so strong that it is confined to earth?

And these questions were answered as I wrote the book.

**What's the answer?** Love continues when you die on the other side.

This was a romantic love story. You wonder, when you die, do they feel it? They know you love them and they don't want you to feel sad anymore.

**Do you have a guiding principle in life?** I have a couple: never to sell oneself out. Many psychics do that. I will never do that. I don't believe in it.

I believe in helping anyone and everyone even if they can't afford it. If I help others, I elevate my karma.

**What will the future bring to Tahoe?** This town will still flourish for the next five to six years. Real estate will continue to blossom. A lot of city folk will be moving up here and making this a new city.

Look at the "Y." You are going to see it flourish in the next year.

**Do you have any bets on it?** No, I never partake in my own predictions.

**Will it snow a lot this year?** The world weather is changing permanently with the ice caps melting and certain climates will become warmer and drier. At times there will be an abundance of snow, and at others there won't be as much.
